## Message from Chairman of QESOSA and QESOSAEPO

Dear Schoolmates,

It is my great honour to be re-elected Chairman of QES Old Students' Association (OSA) and QESOSA Education Promotion Organization (EPO) for 2010-2011.

As part of the tradition now, we have our Annual General Meeting and Annual Dinner on the last Saturday of August each year. On 28 August 2010, over 200 alumni and guests filled the dining hall of Marco Polo Hong Kong Hotel, sharing a joyous evening with old acquaintances and new friends.

One of the objects of OSA is to establish closer relationship between OSA members and Queen Elizabeth School (QES). In 2010-2011, OSA held 4 meetings with QES to explore opportunities for collaboration and ways to support the development of the



School. Among the initiatives was the QES Alumni Mentorship Programme. This year 47 old students enrolled as mentors to coach 250 Secondary 6 and Senior Secondary 2 students. Besides the Kick-off Ceremony on 23 October 2010 and the regular contacts, three company visits were arranged for the mentees to enrich their knowledge of the career world.

The Homecoming Day is a very popular activity for the old students. This year, the Homecoming Day was held on 2 April 2011. Over 100 alumni and their families returned to QES for reunion, to tour the campus and to reminisce the time spent at QES. I am delighted to report that QES has agreed to have the Homecoming Day as a regular annual event.

The ball games tournament was another highlight of the year. This year, we included volleyball game in the tournament in addition to football game and basketball game. The finals of the ball games were played on the Homecoming Day. The three ball games attracted the participation of well over 300 alumni, spanning from 70FA to 13FA. In view of the enthusiastic support of our fellow old students, OSA has planned to repeat the tournament in the coming year.

I would like to express my gratitude to Principal Tong Kwok Keung and his team. Without their full support, the Homecoming Day and the ball games tournament could not have been such a success.

OSA continued to sponsor the Social Service Project of QESOSA Secondary School (QOS) this year. Students of QOS organized three successful functions for the elders and the differently-abled persons in Tin Shui Wai. The Career Awareness Programme (CAP) of QESOSA Tong Kwok Wah Secondary School (QTS) was another project sponsored by OSA. The objective of CAP is to broaden the perspectives of students in career options. In 2010-2011, 6 QES alumni participated in the Programme and a total of 7 company visits were arranged for 53 Secondary 3 and Secondary 4 QTS students.

OSA has set up various channels to enhance communication with our alumni. Besides the OSA official website and the flickr account for sharing OSA activity photos, we have added a facebook account to facilitate timely and two-way communication with our members.

EPO is the School Sponsoring Body for two secondary schools and two primary schools in Tin Shui Wai. During the year, the principals and teachers of the 4 schools worked diligently to prepare for the final countdown of the launch of the through train in the 2011-2012 school year. In fact the Secondary 1 place allocation procedure has been carried out on 10 November 2010. I am pleased to report that a high percentage (over 70%) of parents casted their vote of trust to EPO by choosing to opt-in to our two secondary schools. Under the leadership of the joint school Through Train Steering Committee, the 4 schools will continue to work in a concerted effort to provide students with 12 years of coherent, all-rounded and balanced learning experiences.

The year ahead will be especially challenging for our 2 secondary schools. Besides the Medium of Instruction (MOI) fine tuning arrangement, teachers have to prepare their Secondary 6 students for the first Diploma of Secondary Education Examination and, at the same time, the last batch of Secondary 7 students for the Advanced Level Examination. I am confident that with the professionalism and dedication of our teachers, the potential of our students will be brought to their fullest.

The education services section of EPO continued to offer the Capacity Building Enhancement Programme (CBMP) which mainly targeted women participants as well as the Elder Academy to the Tin Shui Wai Community. Over the years, the 2 programmes are gaining popularity in the community.

During the past year, we have been making good progress in engaging the participation of the younger members, not only as participants, but also as organizers. In the coming year, we will continue our work in serving our fellow students, our alma mater and the community. Your participation in the work and activities of OSA as well as your contribution of ideas to the future development of OSA will be of vital importance. Finally, I would like to take the opportunity to thank each and every one of you who have been contributing your invaluable time and expertise to OSA and EPO.

上述那條航綫的殘舊小輪,有次航行途中突然停電,全船漆黑一片十多分鐘。幸好那個年代的人大都純樸守法,沒聽到有人黑暗中喊叫「非禮!」

說起那西環綫小輪,其屬下員工的態度也令人氣憤:當一衆學生手持月票,魚貫通過售票閘口的轉輪機時,那司閘職員通常不會查看,任由學生順

## **QESOSAEPO Education Services - CBMP**

QESOSA Tong Kwok Wah Secondary School started supporting the Capacity Building Mileage Programme (CBMP) in 2008. This community programme aims to encourage women to improve their all round ability as individuals, and help remove environmental barriers and provide opportunities for women to build up their capacities. In 2010-2011, 9 courses were offered. Among the 148 participants enrolled in the Programme, 52 were parents of EPO school students.

QESOSA EPO has set up a scholarship (家長互助互學獎勵計劃) for EPO school parents to encourage them to set a role model for their children in life long learning. Parents who enroll in and complete the CBMP courses will receive the scholarship. This year, 44 participants were awarded the scholarship amounting to \$8,800. Since the introduction of the Programme, 319 participants have been awarded the scholarship with a cumulated amount of \$63,800.



At the 7<sup>th</sup> Graduation Ceremony of CBMP held on 3 June 2011, 3 EPO school parents were awarded the Level of Certificate: 2 students achieved Level 3 certification and 1 student achieved Level 2 certification.

## QESOSA Education Services – Elder Academy

The QESOSA Education Centre Elder Academy was established in 2007 with the support of QESOSA Secondary School (QOS). Teachers, students and parents of QOS as well as volunteers and staff from social service agencies participated actively to make the Elder Academy a success. The Elder Academy offered a total of 10 courses in the year 2010-2011, with over 189 elders enrolling in the Programme.

A survey was conducted after each semester to collect feedback from elders on the courses offered. For the last three semesters, the elders highly rated the Programme, particularly, the performance of the instructors and the overall programme administration.

In the past year, 7 elders received the Silver Certificate (over 30 learning hours) and 16 elders received the Bronze Certificate (over 20 learning hours) awarded by the Elderly Commission.

The Elder Academy Choir was set up in 2008. Last year the Choir was invited to perform

本會中小學「一條龍」政策將於2011年9月正式落實,即本年度的畢業生可直升本會的兩所中學。本年度無論辦學團體、四校的校長和老師都為一條龍政策的實施而進行大量的工作,除了一條龍督導委員會定期開會制訂有關政策、措施和程序外,亦全面監察和支援有關政策、措施和程序的進展。在全體同工的努力下,得到家長和同學的支持和信任,本年度有72%的畢業同學直接升讀本會的兩所中學,而當中有超過一半被評估為第一組別的同學選擇留在我們的一條龍系統內,成績令人相當鼓舞。我們相信一條龍的辦學模式能為學生提供十二年一貫的基礎和中學教育,有利於學生的全面發展,培養「修己善群」的精神。

本年度本會四所學校的老師繼續為一條龍的銜接而加

強了溝通和協作,進一步為落實一條龍政策作出充分的準備。「合作學習」乃一條龍銜接的主要教與學的策略,因此我們將合作學習作為本年度的其中一個關注事項,進行了一連串有關的教師專業發展活動,讓老師對合作學習有更深入的認識和掌握,我們亦從課堂觀察中,看到大部分老師運用合作學習於教學上已有一定的熟練程度,同時亦觀察到學生從合作學習中有高度的參與,有利於中小學一條龍銜接和提升學與教的效能。

此外,學校亦因應一條龍政策而與本會其他三所學校共同制訂和推行優才發展課程,分別有英文科、數學科和科學科,本年度已開辦了兩期的課程,由兩所中學的老師負責編寫課程和教授,兩所小學的老師協助,讓小學五、六年級在不同學習領域具有高能力的學生參加,有關課程獲得學生和家長廣泛的歡迎,亦有助鼓勵能力高的學生留在一條龍的系統。

學與教是學校最核心的工作,因此亦是學校長期的核心發展項目。本年度我們的老師積極參加各種進修和專業發展活動,所有老師已完成照顧學生特殊學習需要基礎課程,部份老師完成中級和高級課程,推動教師的專業成長。我們透過各種觀課、集體備課、合作學習、教學行動研究、校內和校外的教學分享及交流等活動,推動教師專業發展和能力的提升。整體來說,今年同事在教學策略的運用,尤其是合作學習,和教學效能上均有明顯的提升,給我們很大的鼓舞。

過去一年,學校在教師及職工的努力協作下,得到家長的支持,同學們積極投入學習,我們在正規課程、課外活動以及教師專業發展,取得良好的發展,現簡略報告如下:

## 正規課程

透過推行「合作學習」的教學模式以提升學與教的效能是學校本年度的的課程發展目標。在課堂上所見,同學在合作學習的活動中表現投入,運用互動學習技巧純熟,而溝通及傳意技巧亦有明顯改善,中英文寫作成績更為突出。一位三年級本屬學習困難的同學參加元朗區「給媽媽的情書」比賽中,以真擊感人的文筆獲得冠軍;一位六年級同學在「中國語文菁英計劃」獲得銅獎;多位同學代表學校參加「粵語正音日營」,獲團體第一名,並獲邀在頒獎禮上表演。英文科方面,同學參加元朗區青少年英

文朗誦比賽,有七位同學獲銀獎,五位同學獲銅獎。此外,小五英文優才課程的同學參加Human Values Speech Festival,更獲得一冠一亞的佳績。

我們在數學科十分重視發展同學的邏輯思維、分析和解難能力,學生成績一向優異。本年度同學參加了多項公開校際數學比賽,十四位同學獲多項優異獎,四位同學獲「元朗及天水圍小學魔力橋數學比賽」季軍,一位同學更在新界西小學數學比賽中獲個人獎。





本年度,學校鋭意發展藝術教育,不論在課程設計和活動安排方面,均著意發展同學不同的藝術潛能,並培養同學欣賞藝術的能力。課程設計方面,本校獲藝術發展局頒發「學校藝術教育推廣計畫」優異獎,肯定本校對發展藝術教育的努力。而同學更在不同藝術領域上亦取得突破性成績。

在資訊科技教學方面,我們繼續積極推展遠程視像教學,籌辦多個系列的遠程學習活動,內容涉及正規課程及課外活動,包括埠際及校際辯論比賽,網上學詠春等活動,參與學生涉及小四至小六的同學。同學在這個超越時空的優勢下,完成富趣味和挑戰性的學習任務,不但增加他們對國內文化的認識,更能激發他們的學習動機,擴闊視野,增強自信。此外,我們的資訊科技統籌主任更連續多年獲譤加入「香港遠程教育學會督導委員會」擔任理事會委員,在規劃全港的資訊科技教學方面作出貢獻。

### 延展活動方面

學校延展活動的目標是「擴闊視野,追求卓越」。我們為同學提供多元化的學習經歷,培養他們在不同領域的興趣及專長,發展個人潛能。

本年度共有超過**900**人次參加不同類型的比賽及活動,包括學術、視覺藝術、音樂、體育及個人能力等 範疇,並取得突破性的成績。

在藝術方面,本校繼續舉辦伊分管弦樂團,刻意栽培同學音樂潛能。為讓不同藝術領域具天份的同學有一展身手的機會,學校在上、下學期進行藝墟形式的全校性大型綜合表演活動,活動更獲傳媒報道。此外,在學期終結時亦舉行了綜合才藝表演,接待校內同學、家長及校外幼稚園家長共超過七百多人,而參與各項演出的同學累計超過五百人次。

同時,學校亦安排同學參加不同的校外比賽和活動,同學均表現出色。視覺藝術方面,同學在多項全港性的填色比賽、書簽設計比賽獲冠亞軍獎項。在「香港創意思維活動服飾巡遊匯演暨比賽」中更發揮創意和視藝技巧,利用環保物料創作服飾,擊敗多隊強隊勇奪全港冠軍。同學在音樂及舞蹈藝術方面亦盡顯才華,



包括有一位同學在校際音樂節中取得小提琴冠軍,亦有多位同學在鋼琴、獨唱及合唱組別獲三甲及優良獎項。在舞蹈方面,有兩位同學在「第七屆香港校際體育舞蹈錦標賽暨香港排名賽」分別獲查查舞(cha-cha)、牛仔舞及倫巴舞冠軍,其中一位同學更在澳門埠際比賽中獲三甲獎項。

在體育方面,學校自建造標準跳遠跑道和沙池後, 跳遠訓練更為專業化,同學亦取得極佳成績,一位五年 級同學囊括元朗區及全港跳遠冠軍。學校自成立小型網 球訓練班後,亦人才輩出,一位一年級同學參加多項全 港性小型網球比賽,屢創佳續,多次獲七歲組別的冠軍 及季軍。我校的體操隊除在

體操比賽上多次獲團體優異成績外,亦參加元朗博愛醫院主辦的全港啦啦隊比賽,獲金獎及最佳口號獎。女子手球隊參加青少年小型手球錦標賽,在中、小學混合公開組中亦奪得亞軍。在象棋方面,同學參加馬振玉體育藝術邀請賽小學中國象棋賽中亦獲得優異獎第一名和個人賽亞軍。

同學在延展活動方面取得卓越的成就,實有賴教師團隊的承擔與努力、家 長們的鼎力支持與及同學們的積極參與。

## 教師專業發展方面

為了配合屬會「一條龍」政策,我們四所學校的教師組成了一個專業學習社群,共同研習「合作學習」,讓四所學校在教學策略作出銜接,增強學習的果效。我們的中、英、數教師互相開放教室,運用「合作學習」施教,屬會同工進行觀課、評課等交流分享的專業培訓活動,透過專業對話,探討實施「合作學習」可行和有效的方案。從觀課所見,本校絕大部分教師對運

用合作學習具信心,而同學亦十分投入合作學習活動,運用互動技巧純熟,課堂效能有明顯提升。

本年度,學校獲教育局課程發展處邀請,推薦一位英文科教師參加支援內地教師交流計劃,成為全港十所小學的其中之一。此計劃一方面讓本校教師有機會全面參與支援內地英文教學工作,提升課程發展及教學效能,同時更安排內地與本地友校教師到本校進行教學交流,促進教師專業發展。活動後,教育局及內地教師對本校師生表現一致稱許,活動亦令本校與內地姊妹學校有更緊密的聯繫,為日後專業交流奠定基礎。

過去一年,學校雖然面對種種挑戰和衝擊,但在良好和穩健的基礎上,加上校董和家長的信任和支持,令專業的教師團隊對學校辦學宗旨及理念更清晰和更認同,更努力加以實踐,使學校各項工作順利過度,教學成效有所提升。從小一收生情況,家長的口碑,反映出區內家長對學校的支持和信任。家長一直都是學校的合作夥伴,也是學校的重要資源,我們十多位家長理事,以及近百位家長義工,為學校、學生勞心勞力,付出時間和精神,讓同學經歷多姿多采的校園生活,謹此向他們衷心致謝。

## **QESOSA Secondary School 2010-2011 School Report**

## Staff Strength

In addition to the standard establishment under the Code of Aid, our school was able to secure other funds to recruit 18 additional teachers, giving a total teaching staff strength of 77. Among which, 42% held higher degrees while another 57% were degree holders. 99% had been professionally trained. All teachers of English Language and Putonghua met the requirements of the Language Proficiency Assessment.

## **Public Examinations Result**

Students had good performance in the 2011 Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination. 8 subjects got 100% pass and the passing rates of 5 other subjects were over 95%. The overall passing rate was 93.1%. Use of English attained a passing rate of 90% which was 15% higher than Hong Kong norm. About 92% of the subjects had a credit rate higher than those of the Hong Kong norm. 8 subjects got credit rates of 47% or higher. 81.4% of the students attained the minimum entrance requirements for local degree courses.

## Inter-school Activities and Awards Won

In 2010-2011, we had more and more students demonstrating excellent performance in territory wide competitions and learning events. Some of them were even granted the honour of representing Hong Kong to attend international contests and learning programmes held overseas. An S2 student was selected by the Young Astronaut Training Programme by the Hong Kong Space Museum to attend the astronaut training in Beijing. 2 students were selected to join the World Rope Skipping Championships held in UK and 1 student was selected as a member of the Hong Kong Team to attend the East Asian Football Championship held in Thailand.

In the Hong Kong Speech Festival, our Chinese team won one First Place, 6 Second Places and 14 Third Places. Our English team won 5 First Place, 5 Second Place and 2 Third Places. In the Yuen Long District Speech Competition, our English team won 2 Gold, 7 Silver and 14 Bronze Medals. In the World Music Fiesta organized by the Hong Kong Economic Times, our students won the 1st Runner-up and the best booth design award.

In the Hong Kong Budding Scientists Award 2010-2011 organized by the Education Bureau, 1 student was awarded Second Class Honour and 2 students were awarded Third Class Honour. In the Hong Kong & Macao Mathematical Olympiad Open Contest, 1 Gold, 4 Silver and 12 Bronze Awards were gained. A Silver Award was won in the Hong Kong Mathematics' Creative Problem Solving Competition organized by Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. In the National Hua Luo-geng Cup



Mathematics Competition, a Bronze Medal was won. A Gold Award was gained in the Yuen Long Tuen Mun District Youth Science Sharing Day organized by Yuen Long Town Hall.

Students' performance in project learning was also outstanding. Our students captured 2 Gold Awards at the 6th Tuen Mun and Yuen Long Youth Scientific Enquiry and Creativity Competition. Their performance was so remarkable that they finally won the Northwest Youth Outreach United Cup. In the "Country Parks Reporter" Inter-school Competition organized by the Agricultural, Fisheries and Conservation Department, our students won the Second Place in the Junior Section. We also won the Best Design Award in the Creative Tourism Enterprises Competition, the Energy-saving Design of Living Space Bronze Award and the Best Presentation Award in the Built Environment and Sustainable Development Energy Saving through Social Design Competition. In the NSS & ESD Programme, our students gained the Grand ESD Award, and the Built Environment Group won the Second Place.

## **QESOSAEPO Schools - QESOSA Secondary School**

Students continued to have good performance in visual arts. In the "Star River" National Children's Fine Arts, Calligraphy & Photography contest, our students won the 1st Grand Award. A Championship was won in "Appreciation of Your Family" comic drawing competition organized by Yuen Long District Council. The Grand Prizes and 3 Honourable Mentions award are gained in the Exhibition of Secondary School Students' Creative Visual Arts Work organized by Education Bureau.

3 Champions, 6 First-runner-up, 4 Second-runner-up and numerous awards were received in our sports competition including swimming, athletics, cross country running, rope skipping, football, volleyball, handball and korfball. Our students won the Boys' Overall Second Runner-up and Girls' Overall First Runner-up in the overall Yuen Long Inter-school Sports Competition.

## Sustainable Development Education

Our school continued to have outstanding performance in the promotion of education for sustainable development in 2010-2011. In recognition of our school's efforts and contribution in sustainable development, we were granted Gold Award and the highest honour of "Outstanding Performance Award" by the Council for Sustainable Development. This year, our school adopted "sustainable fishing" as the theme. Students explored how the traditional oyster and fish breeding industries in Hong Kong could increase their competitive edge through sustainable way of operation. The adjudication panel commented that the keys for our school to winning the Award were the project's unique theme, innovative activities and its holistic approach that involved the school and the community.



## Voluntary Optimisation of Class Structure Scheme

To help creating a healthy ecology for our education sector and to provide better learning environment for our students, our school decided to join the Voluntary Optimisation of Class Structure Scheme initiated by the Education Bureau. According to the scheme, our school will reduce 1 class in each level in the future years. However, due to the commitment we have made to our through-train primary students and the large number of current through-train P6 students that opted to study in our school, our school will continue to offer 5 classes of S1 in 2011-2012. The actual number of S1 classes offered in each of the future years will depend on the actual number of through-train P6 students admitted.

## Through-train

Starting from 2011-2012, our school will operate under the through-train mode with our 3 other sister schools. All students from our 2 QESOSA primary schools who would like to stay in our through-train were admitted by either our school or our sister school QESOSA Tong Kwok Wah Secondary School. In 2010-2011, a lot of preparatory work and collaboration among the 4 sister schools were made for the smooth bridging of the primary and secondary education curricula. A Variety of student activities and learning programmes were provided for the primary school students to get more familiar with the curriculum of our secondary schools. The opt-in rate of the current through-train P6 students to our school was very high.

## 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary



In 2010-2011, our school was entering her 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary and various programmes were organized for celebration. The theme of our celebration activities was the extolling of our school motto "Vos Parate Ut Serviatis". A Charity Walkathon called "Walking with Tin Shui Wai" was organized to signify our love and commitment to our community. Funds raised were to be used in supporting our students in service learning. To share our mission and experiences with other educators, various professional sharing sessions were arranged in the areas of education for sustainable development, curriculum development and professional growth. Moreover, student activities such as speech festival, project learning, and art competition were organized to promote human values and green messages.

## **QESOSA Tong Kwok Wah Secondary School 2010-2011 School Report**

"It is often said that when your school possesses the most critical natural resources namely motivated students, professional staff and supportive parents, good things, necessarily, are going to happen in your school".

## School Profile

Our sixth year heralded renewed energy to sustain education practices and management policies that are both effective and nurturing. We have taken consistent and carefully considered measures to initiate ideas to address challenges that we, as a collective, must resolve with determination and harmony of spirit.

## Class Structure

The class structure of 2010-2011 school year is 5-5-6-6-2 from secondary one to secondary six, making a total of 29 classes. Since the school has joined the Voluntary Optimization of Class Structure Scheme of Education Bureau (EDB), the number of secondary one classes will be reduced to 4 from 2011-12 onward.

## Holistic Approach to Strengthening the Curriculum

In our 2009-2012 School Development Plan, we have allocated additional time for strengthening and enhancing student learning. We will continue to offer Saturday school for our graduating cohorts in the coming academic year to better prepare them in various subjects. Over and above the formal curriculum focused perspective of academia, we also utilized additional resources to improve the on-going study skills programmes, good learning habits and sound character education initiatives through our pastoral care programmes.

## Staff Strength

On top of the standard establishment granted by EDB, we were able to strengthen our staff to 72 teachers, a total of 13 additional teachers have joined us. Among all teachers, 97% is degree holder 24% holds higher degree and 81% had been professionally trained. All English teachers have attained the required language proficiency stated by EDB.

## Student Learning Enhancement Initiatives

## Student Platforms of Participation

Student's engagement and involvement are valued highly in decision making processes in school affairs. The school is making good ground in preparing students to participate more confidently in student body activities. Platforms of participation in decision making are also being encouraged through class representatives meetings, form associations and house committee meetings. The Student Union has initiated a consultative conference over the school timetabling

in the coming academic year and has represented their fellow schoolmates in the Lunch Arrangement Supervision Committee to advice on catering services at school. It is heartening to see students making suggestions and giving constructive ideas during their discussions.



One area of improvement we are focusing on is English language medium of instruction in the three subject areas in secondary one. This initiative is in response to the MOI fine tuning arrangements made by the EDB. English MOI classes will continue to be offered in secondary two and selected subject areas in secondary one.





## **QESOSAEPO Schools - QESOSA TKW Secondary School**

Hence there has been a push to improve our English attainment level and academic performance through different ideas like offering English as a medium of instruction (EMI) subject delivery in secondary one subjects including geography, science and mathematics. Students were given more opportunities to be exposed to English and thereby getting more acquainted with English as a medium of learning.

Lesson plans and learning resources are designed to enhance the use of English language in the subject specific genre of the three above mentioned subject disciplines. Carefully selected geography and science readers and magazines are part of secondary one classes learning resources. This effort has been coordinated through our cross faculty teachers, native English teachers, supervisors of Humanities and English faculties.

### English across the Curriculum: the Musical

Our students' collaborative learning spirit is commendable and noteworthy in the various events in our school calendar. One such event is the English musical production wherein the senior students worked closely with the junior students in small work groups on stage and back stage to make the production not only of an excellent standard but also develop respectful working relationships based on trust and friendship for approximately three hundred student participants .



## 2010-2011 Highlights and Achievements

The highlights for the academic year 2010-2011 strongly reflect the effort and diligence of students, coaches and teachers. We are pleased by the environmental awareness and healthy practice of our students and staff in building a green school. For the period September 2010 - June 2011, our school was recognized at the 8th HK Green School Award and received a Certificate of Appreciation in the secondary school category.

In the 2010 Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival (English Speech), our school won a first place, a third place and 27 Certificate of Merit.



2010-2011 was a fruitful year for our debating team. The team participated in the HK Debate: Economics category and was the proud Outstanding Team winner and also attained the 'Best Speakers Award'. The debating team joined the 27<sup>th</sup> New Territories Joint School Debating Competition and was the 2nd Runners up.

We encourage our students to participate in competitions in a variety of subject disciplines. Our school is the Champion for the fourth consecutive year in the Geo-Catching Hunting Competition and also the winner in the Robotics Intelligence DIY in the Yuen Long Inter-School Information Technology Olympiad. Well done, to all the budding scientists in our school!

The art talent of our students was exemplified in the "ArTram: Fantasy Playground Design Competition" organized by Hong Kong Arts Development Council. Almost 250 primary and secondary schools participated in the Competition, and our team won the Grand Prize of the competition, The winning design would be featured on the exteriors of Hong Kong Tramways trams and in K11.

Following on with sporting highlights, our boys were the 2010-2011 Overall Champions in the Yuen Long Interschool Athletics Competition. The Boys A grades & B grades were awarded winning placements. The Boys C grade won the first prize in their category. In the Yuen Long district cross country competition the Boys C team and the Girls C team got the first and the third placement respectively. Our school basketball team got the fourth placement in the Yuen Long district basketball competition.

In addition, we are pleased that our school won the championship of Marathon 101 Youth Cup Girls' Division and Marathon 101 Education Cup in the Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2011. Another moment of celebration is that one of our students was selected a national representative of the Hong Kong Athletics Association team. It is indeed a great honour and outstanding opportunity for the student!






### 成績表

- 早早退咗休要慶祝;


- 主角唔得閒都要慶祝;
